

Joint Statement on the Creation of the Steam Plant Demolition Community Advisory Group

Council Speaker Julie Menin, Congressman Jerrold Nadler, State Senator Liz Krueger, Assembly Member Rebecca Seawright, the New York City Department of Housing Preservation and Development (HPD), the New York City Department of Buildings (DOB), and the Roosevelt Island Operating Corporation (RIOC) are pleased to announce the formation of a Roosevelt Island Steam Plant Community Advisory Group (CAG):

The Community Advisory Group will provide a forum for community representatives to receive updates, ask questions, and share feedback regarding the city's ongoing demolition of the former Steam Plant on Roosevelt Island. The group will meet once a month for the duration of the demolition project.

All Community Advisory Group meetings will be held virtually via Microsoft Teams. Members will have the opportunity to submit questions in advance to HPD and DOB, the agencies overseeing the demolition work.

The Community Advisory Group is modeled after similar advisory bodies established for major public projects throughout New York City and is intended to help facilitate regular communication between project stakeholders and the Roosevelt Island community.

The first meeting will be held on June 17th via Microsoft Teams.
