- With a focus on innovative and environmentally friendly solutions, RIOC is committed to providing services that enhance the island's residential community.
- RIOC manages the two-mile long island's roads, parks, buildings, a sports facility, and public transportation, including the iconic aerial tramway.
- Additionally, RIOC operates a Public Safety Department that helps maintain a safe and secure environment for residents, employees, business owners, and visitors.

RIOC Red Bus

Description

RIOC operates a fleet of free Red Buses that serve island residents and visitors across 17 stops.

Approximately 4000-5000 people ride the Red Bus every day.

Typical rush hour service sees 3-4 Red Buses on the road.

RIOC currently has 5 active Red Buses in its fleet and expects to have 7 in operation by early 2025.

Description

The Roosevelt Island Tramway is an iconic part of the city's fabric.

Approximately 2 million riders rode the Tram in 2023.

In 2024, Tram ridership is on pace to reach 2.8 million.



Lamppost Banners

Description

Roosevelt Island has one "Main" Street that all vehicular traffic utilizes.

Lamppost Banners line the street and offer an eye-catching opportunity for advertisers to highlight their business or organization.

Advertisers can also choose where they want their banners hung (pending availability).



Lamppost Banners

Ad Fee

\$400/month per banner

Package: \$1,000 for 3 months per banner

Specifications:

Orientation: Portrait

Size: 30 inches wide by 60 inches tall

Print sides: Double sided

Material: Vinyl with wind slits OR full mesh

Accessories: 3 inch diameter pole pockets

on the top and bottom

Optional: 4 grommets at each corner

Non-profit Ad Fee

\$320/month per banner

Package: \$800 for 3 months

Special Instructions:

Must specify the location for each banner by the pole identification number (see picture). Location is not guaranteed.

Additional installation and removal fee:

\$100 per lamppost


